

## TAKE A SWING AT THE TWO 18-HOLE GOLF COURSES ON GRAND BAHAMA ISLAND.



### The Lucayan Country Club

The Lucayan Course is an 18-hole golf course designed by renowned golf course architect Dick Wilson, open since 1962. Masters and US Open winner Craig Wood was the first professional (worked at famous Winged Foot in summers) and often declared the Lucayan Dick Wilson's finest design. A little known fact is that Craig Wood actually worked hands on with Wilson during the design and build of the course! 44 years after its birth,



The Lucayan Country Club is still maintained as if Wilson were still walking its fairways. His perfectly balanced classic design features six relatively straight holes, six holes with definite left to right routings and six holes which favour the right to left shot makers.

- Lessons available by teaching professional with appointment .
- Dress code: Reasonable resort code. Shirts must have collars and Bermuda length shorts with pockets are required. No bathing suits or gym shorts.

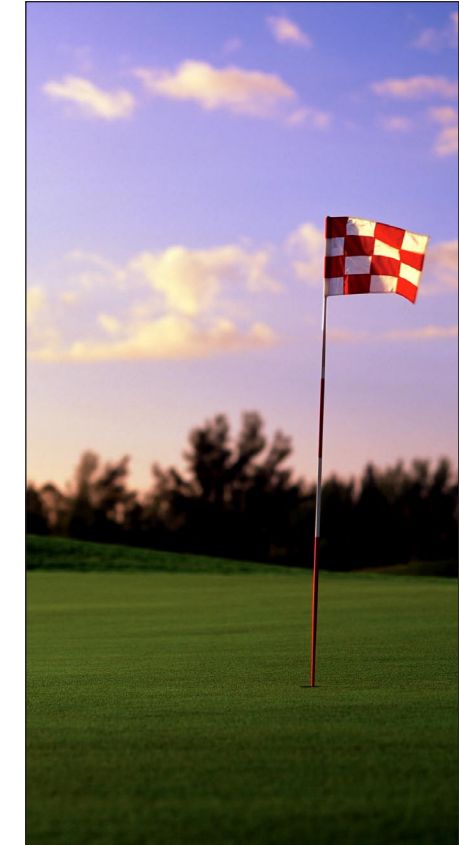
### The Reef Course

The Reef Course is an 18-hole links-style golf course designed by renowned golf course architect Robert Trent Jones Jr. Jones is the son of RTJ Sr. who, along with Dick Wilson, were the top two American golf architects, with fierce competition for decades. It was no accident that the resort has a Jones course and a Wilson layout!

The Reef Course opened in 2000 by hosting The Our Lucaya PGA Senior Slam, won by Hale Irwin. In recent championship play (Bahamas National Amateur) the Reef Course averaged two strokes more difficult than Lucayan, although to many it appears the easier test.

- Course has 57 bunkers, 11 lakes and open fairways, water comes into play on 13 of the 18 holes. Stay out of the native rough to score decently.
